

WHY? WHY? WHY?


- What have these people done to deserve this? Were they worse sinners than us?

Jesus answered, "Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans because they suffered this way? I TELL YOU, NO!



The one without sin suffered and died on the cross.




They are worse sinners than we are... and that is why they suffer or they are poor (Not so)




We are all sinners before God!

I tell you, NO! BUT unless you repent you will likewise perish.


